Entries submitted after these dates or submitted without proper deposits are considered late and will incur a \$75 Late Fee.

TRAINERS (only for trainers with multiple horses in their barn):

You may reserve stalls for your barn in advance to insure that you have enough stalls and all of your clients are stabled together.

- 1) Go to www.fieldstoneshowpark.com, go to Shows/Forms and click on the show name you are reserving stalls for
- 2) Click on "Trainer Stall Form" which will open a fillable form in PDF that you should be able to complete online. If you cannot open it or you do not have the Adobe Acrobat program on your computer, simply go to www.adobe.com and follow the directions to download a free version of Adobe Acrobat Reader. This will allow you to open it and have the convenience of completing it all online. If you prefer to print it out, complete it by hand, scan it as a PDF and email it back, you may do so.
- 3) Click on the "Click Here To Submit" button on the bottom ... this will send the form directly to the horse show via email as long as you are connected to the internet. You can also save it as a PDF and attach it to an email (FSPShowOffice@gmail.com).

Instruct your clients to enter the shows online ... when completing their entry blank, make sure they select a horse stall and pay for it along with the Office / Facility Fee. Ideally, the total number of horse stalls you reserve will match the number of entries received from your clients. See the form for further information and directions.

EXHIBITORS / TRAINERS:

- 1) Go to www.horseshowing.com and click on "Enter Shows", then on the next screen click on "Click Here To Enter Online"
- 2) Log in (or create account if this is your first time), then on the next screen click on "Create Entries"
- 3) Enter "FSP" into the "Type Show Name" box, select show you are entering and you will be taken to the "Create Entry" screen
- 4) Click on "Select Horse" and choose the horse you are entering, then complete horse and owner organization numbers
- 5) Click on "Select Trainer or No Trainer" and choose your trainer's name and complete trainer organization numbers
- 6) Click on "Select Rider 1", select rider's name, complete organization numbers, enter classes / sections … repeat for Rider 2
- 7) Click on "Fees" and choose a Horse Stall or Haul-In Fee (if you are hauling in daily and not using a stall) ... do not select any tack stalls as your trainer should do so on their Trainer Stall Form ... if you are an individual not showing with a trainer, then select a tack stall if needed ... the Office / Facility Fee should already be selected
- 8) Click on "Signatures", read USEF / USHJA Entry Blank disclaimer, check the boxes and type the names for each owner, rider, trainer and parent / guardian to acknowledge and agree
- 9) Click on "Save" and you will be asked if you wish to create another entry ... if you do, click on "yes" and repeat steps above
- 10) When done with all of your horse entries, you will be taken to the Dashboard screen where you can Edit, View, Delete or Clone each horse's entry ... you must then click on "Select For Submission" for each entry you are making
- 11) Scroll down to "Pay Show By" and select Credit (complete credit card info) or Check (mail check)
- 12) Scroll further down and select "Sign USEF Waivers" and check each box that applies to each person associated with the entry, check the "I acknowledge that ..." box and complete the signatures and names, click on the "Send Signed Waiver" box
- 13) Scroll part-way back up and click on the big black "Submit" box
- 14) You will be taken to the "Pay Show Deposit" screen. Payment must accompany your entry and may be done as follows:
 - a) If you selected the Credit option, complete all of the information. Remember, you must pay both the Office / Facility Fee and the Stall Fee or Haul-In Fee for your entry to be accepted. If you wish to have your final bill upon closeout charged to this same card, check either "Please Save This Card For Future Use" option before submitting. This transaction will be charged immediately upon submission and a non-refundable 3% Convenience Fee will be added to all credit transactions.
 - b) If you wish to pay by check, click on the "Check" option and submit your entry. Then mail a check, payable to FSP, to Kendis Collman, 29455 N Cave Creek Road, Suite 118-430, Cave Creek, AZ 85331. Be sure to write the Confirmation Number given when submitting your entry on the memo line. This check must be received by the entry closing date. Checks received AFTER entry closing date or not received at all will result in a \$75 Late Fee added to your account. DO NOT MAIL A CHECK AFTER THE ENTRY CLOSING DATE AS IT MAY NOT BE RECEIVED IN TIME.
- 15) If you pay with a credit card and check the "Save This Card" option of your choice, your card can automatically be charged when closing out at the end of the show. If you pay with a credit card and do not check any "Save This Card" option or you pay by check, you will be required to do a credit card swipe or leave a signed, open check with the office upon checking in. Your trainer may pick up your number and have your account guaranteed by their Trainer Account. In this case, the account will be charged to the Trainer's Account upon closeout if no other form of payment is provided by the time of checkout.

GOLF CARTS: Golf carts must be rented off grounds and delivered. Show does not provide golf carts.

ARRIVAL / DEPARTURE: Horses may arrive after noon on Mondays. Arrival before noon will incur a \$40 per stall charge.

JUMPER NOMINATING FEE: Horses competing in jumper classes requiring a Jumper Nominating Fee will be charged \$175 upon entry into any of these classes. It is not required to be paid in advance when submitting entries. If you do not compete in any of these classes, you will not be charged for it.

OFFICE / FACILITY FEE: Every horse must pay a \$100 Office / Facility Fee when submitting entries for a show. This fee includes office supplies, processing and costs, online access fees, medical coverage and facility use / access.

STABLING: Tent stalls are approximately 10'x10' with doors and dirt floors, and rent for \$350 per show. Permanent stalls in the Red Barn are approximately 10'x10' with dutch doors and dirt floors, and rent for \$275 per show. Frame tent stalls are filled first, then all others will be in regular pole tent stabling or permanent red barns. You may request the permanent red barns on the stall form if you wish. Day Stalls are not available. Stalls are non-transferable and may not be shared or resold.

SHAVINGS: Contract requirements supersede USEF GR1216.7. Competitors are prohibited from bringing their own shavings or having such delivered onto Fieldstone Show Park property. Shavings must be purchased through the facility on the grounds.

HAUL-IN FEE: A one-time Haul-In Fee of \$50 will be charged for horses that are showing and have not purchased a stall. This allows a horse to haul-in, tie to a trailer and show. Horses claiming a Haul-In Fee but using a stall, even briefly, will be charged a stall fee.

ADDING REGULAR CLASSES: If you wish to add a regular class after initially checking in and picking up your number, you must do so by 5pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before the class is to be held. Adds after this time or same day adds will only be allowed if the schedule in that ring is not full. There is no charge to add a regular class. Adding classes online will be locked at 5:00pm and will not be available after that time. You must come to the office after 7:00am the next day to make entries or changes.

SCRATCHING REGULAR CLASSES: If you do not intend to show in a regular class you have entered, you MUST scratch it in the horse show office BEFORE the start of the class. Scratches may not be done after a class has started. Scratching at the back gate is not permitted and simply not showing up for your class will result in forfeiture of the entry fee. Scratching classes online will be locked at 5:00pm and will not be accepted after that time. You must come to the office after 7:00am the next day to make entries or changes.

ADDING / SCRATCHING SPECIAL CLASSES: Adds and scratches should be made by 5pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before the class is held. Adds after this time, if accepted, will pay a Post Entry Fee and must go first in the order. Scratches from these classes must be done in the horse show office by 5pm or close of office, whichever comes first, the day before the class is held. Scratches after this time will forfeit the entry fee unless due to an injury to horse or rider and a vet certificate (from the official horse show veterinarian only) or medical release form (from the official horse show medical personnel only) is presented to the office at the time of the scratch. See specific exceptions on Special Classes page.

SHOW SCRATCH (a horse entered but scratched from the entire show prior to going in any classes): On or before the closing date of entries: If you entered via credit card, it will be refunded (except for the Convenience Fee, which is non-refundable); If you sent in a check, it will be shredded (checks are not deposited before entry closing date).



RULES, REGULATIONS & GENERAL INFORMATION

After the closing date of entries, the \$100 Office / Facility Fee and Stall Fee are not refundable under any circumstances and are forfeited as a Show Scratch Fee. Any other fees paid in advance are fully refundable (except for any Convenience Fee, which is non-refundable). Show scratches in which the horse doesn't come to the show must be done by the start of the show. Show scratches after the start of the show must be requested before the end of the show. No show scratch refund requests will be processed after the show is over.

EQUITATION ENTRIES: Equitation riders must wear the number of the horse they are entered on. Numbers are assigned to horses, not riders. If a rider wishes to change horses for an equitation class, they may do so without penalty; however, the proper paperwork must be completed in the show office prior to the start of the class. Exhibitors changing horses without notifying the office will forfeit their entry fee on the original horse and be charged the entry fee plus an RDNE Fee on the new horse.

SUBSTITUTIONS: With a vet's certificate, a new horse may be substituted for a show scratched horse as long as the scratched horse has not shown in any classes and both horses are registered under the same trainer. The scratched horse's Registration Fee and Stall Fee are transferred to the substituted horse with no penalty or charge.

RETURNED CHECKS: Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense. A 10% PENALTY WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EVERY RETURNED CHECK (MINIMUM OF \$50.00)! Accounts will be given seven (7) days to be paid in full with cash or credit card or they will be turned into the USEF for disciplinary action.

RDNE (Rode Did Not Enter): Entries that show in a class not properly entered will be charged the class entry fee plus a \$25 RDNE Fee. Starters are not responsible for keeping you out of classes that you are not officially entered in. If you 'crash' the gate and go into a class you are not entered in a ring that is closed to same day adds, you will be charged the class entry fee plus a \$50 RDNE Fee.

CREDIT CARD TRANSACTIONS: Visa, Mastercard, Discover and American Express can be used for payment of your Entry Deposit / Stall Fee when entering and your final bill when closing out. All credit card transactions will incur a 3% Convenience Fee. This fee is paid to a third-party Merchant Account and is therefore non-refundable under any circumstances.

PRIZEMONEY / AWARDS: Prize money will be deducted from your bill when possible at the time of close-out. Any unpaid amounts or amounts over the final bill will be mailed to the owner or listed payee in the form of a check within 30 days after the conclusion of the show. Social Security or Federal Tax ID number of OWNER or PAYEE, along with a completed IRS Form W9 is required before any prize money will be paid. All purses and add-backs shall be divided as follows unless otherwise specified: 1st - 30%, 2nd - 22%, 3rd - 15%, 4th - 12%, 5th - 11% and 6th - 10%. Ribbons shall be awarded to eighth place in all regular hunter classes and classics and sixth place in all equitation and medal classes, unless otherwise stated.

MEDICAL WASTE / SHARPS CONTAINERS: Sharps must be placed in the proper receptacles located in every barn. Violations shall be subject to a \$50 fine per occurrence.

MONEY / STAKE CLASS ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible for a money or stake class, entry must have entered and shown in at least one other class in the same section at the show, unless otherwise stated.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

DOGS: USEF GR1301.6 Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a Yellow warning card and may be subject to penalty under Chapter 7.

PARKING: Illegal parking anywhere will result in a fine of \$50 per occurrence. This fine will be placed on your horse show account and becomes a part of your financial obligation to the show. Further fines, ticketing and/or towing will result for multiple offenders. Trainers may be held accountable for any parking fines incurred by their staff.

DAMAGE / HOLES IN STALLS & BARN WALLS: Exhibitors will be held responsible for damage caused by them, their agents or employees, and will be billed accordingly. Holes punched in any stall or barn wall, or any use of an existing hole, will result in a fine of \$25 per hole punched or used, regardless of who made the hole. Facility staff inspect stalls daily and will charge the horse show for any violations.

CONFLICTS: Management cannot allow conflicts to hold up rings. Riders with potential conflicts must arrange their jumping order with the starters so that they will not hold up a class. Trainer conflicts cannot be recognized. If you are a trainer, be sure to bring enough help to get your horses and clients to the rings in a timely manner or only bring a manageable number of horses if you are limited in the help you have.

TRAINER SPLITS: These shows offer a service that allows trainers to have their tack stalls split evenly amongst their client's horse show bills by completing a Trainer Split Form. See the office for deadlines for submitting this form. Uncollected splits will revert back to the trainer. Clients cannot check-out until this form is submitted by their trainer.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: USEF GR801 It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. A Show Committee, Competition Management, and Licensed Officials must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required.

JOGGING: USEF HU118.3 Option A - Horses / ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses / ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

USEF RULE GR901.11: The horse show policies stated herein regarding scratches and refunds will be followed regardless of weather and in place of USEF Rule GR901.11.

SCHOOLING: No schooling permitted, at any time, in any of the show rings, except during a scheduled warm-up class. **Use the designated schooling areas ONLY.** Please do not school or lunge on the grass!

POLING: Poling and/or the use of bamboo pole offsets are prohibited. Any rider or trainer found poling or using offsets and/or who, on the opinion of the judges or committee, uses their whip or spurs in an excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred, be suspended from further showing for a 24 hour period, and will forfeit entry fees for that class. Any horse upon which a violation of the manual poling and/or use of bamboo offset rule is perpetrated will be suspended from competition for a 24 hour period starting from the time of the incident, and will forfeit all entry fees. Any further violations by that exhibitor on the same horse or another horse will result in said exhibitor being barred from any further competition at the show.

ANIMAL WELFARE: We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times while the horse is on the showgrounds we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse. Exhibitors are cautioned that GR839 which defines the USEF's policy on abuse and GR803 which pertains to the use of whips, will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of a bamboo off-set, or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. Any handling and veterinary treatment should ensure their health and welfare. High standards of nutrition, health, sanitation and safety shall be maintained at all times. Adequate provision should be made for ventilation, feeding and watering and maintaining a healthy environment. Any method of riding and training should take account of the horse as a living entity and must not include any technique considered to be abusive. The well being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators are subject under the above rules to elimination from competition and to protest or charge with resulting formal proceedings which may result in severe fines, suspensions or other penalties.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: All horses entering the Fieldstone Show Park grounds must have valid proof of negative coggins test (within 12 months) and proof of mandatory vaccinations as required per USEF rules. A 30 day certificate of veterinary inspection is required for all horses arriving from outside the state of Massachusetts. Horses who fail to arrive with appropriate paperwork may not be allowed to unload on show grounds. Documents should be presented upon request.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber and competing only in classes that are exempt from membership requirements, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless and until USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my Fan account. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

STATEMENT AS TO FEDERATION FEE (GR208.1)

For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a Federation Fee will be collected (a portion of the fee shall be an Equine Drugs and Medication fee to provide for research, inspection, and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see GR407.1, .2 and .3). Exception: Horses entered in classes exempted from the Equine Drugs and Medication fee are also exempt from the balance of the Federation fee.
